1. PANICSELLING — A condition of the stock market where investors take fright and start selling a particular share with little regard to the price they sell at thereby pushing down its price (12)
3. OPENOUTCRY — A system of trading at the stock exchange floor where brokers shout their bids and offers of securities (10)
4. OVERSUBSCRIPTION — A situation in which the demand for shares in an initial public offering exceeds the number of shares issued (16)
5. OVERVALUED — The current price is not justifiable when measured by such benchmarks like the price to earnings ratio (10)
6. OPTION — The right but not the obligation to buy or sell shares at a specified time (6)
7. ORDERIMBALANCE — A situation in which buy orders for a particular stock greatly outnumber the sell orders or vice versa, making it impossible to match the orders (14)

1. PERATIO — Calculated by dividing the market price per share by earnings registered in the last twelve months (7)
2. PDRATIO — Calculated by dividing the price of the share by the last paid out dividend (7)
3. OVERHEATED — Market in which too much money is chasing too few shares leading to sharp price rises (10)
7. OTC — Market where shares or other securities which are not listed in the main stock exchange are traded (3)
